Parents, teachers, administrators, and MMS staff members all share in developing and maintaining high expectation for our students' academic success. Both experience and research demonstrate that a child's educational success depends upon the development of a strong partnership between home and school. The following information will be helpful in enabling you to become an active member of our "Community of Learners."

Textbooks

MMS students work from class sets of textbooks that are issued to their teachers at the beginning of the year. Textbooks are issued to students for use at home at the request of the parents or at the direction of their teachers. Once issued, the parent assumes responsibility for the replacement cost of the textbook should it be lost or stolen while in their possession.

Clearing Absences

Parents and guardians are asked to contact the attendance clerk before 12:00 PM (noon) on the day of the absence. Absences not cleared within 24 hours will be considered unexcused. It is the responsibility of the student to secure and return all makeup work. You are encouraged to work closely with your student's team teachers in regards to attendance.

Dress Code

The MMS Dress Code applies to all students attending school and will be enforced. Please consult the Code of Conduct concerning dress code prior to wearing any clothing that may be in question. Any class time lost due to a dress code violation will be treated in the same way as an attendance violation.

Immunizations

Recent changes to the Texas Immunization Laws now require that all student shot and immunization records be current prior to the student enrolling in school. There is, however, an exception that allows dependents of active duty personnel an additional thirty (30) days to complete the record without a delay in enrollment.
